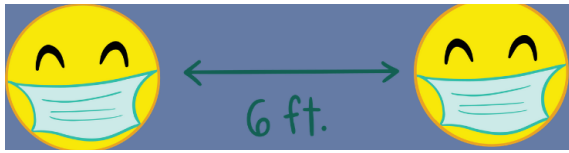

Covid Reminders



Covid Guidelines were updated by the Province as of February 14, 2022.

MASKS MUST BE WORN

The formal gathering limit is now 50% of a room or venue's capacity.

Household or close social groups that do not need to be distanced is now up to 25 persons.

You must stay home and participate online if you have any Covid symptoms

Communion may only be received in the hand
You are encouraged to use the hand sanitizers provided at the entrance to the church

Limit washroom use as much as possible

Proof of vaccination is not required, however everyone is encouraged to get vaccinated

The Saturday 4pm Mass at Corpus Christi St. Joseph Kentville requires Proof of Vaccination.

Collection baskets will remain at the entrances/exits for weekly offerings. Consider making your offering via e-transfer or PAR.

Daily Mass attendance must follow these protocols.

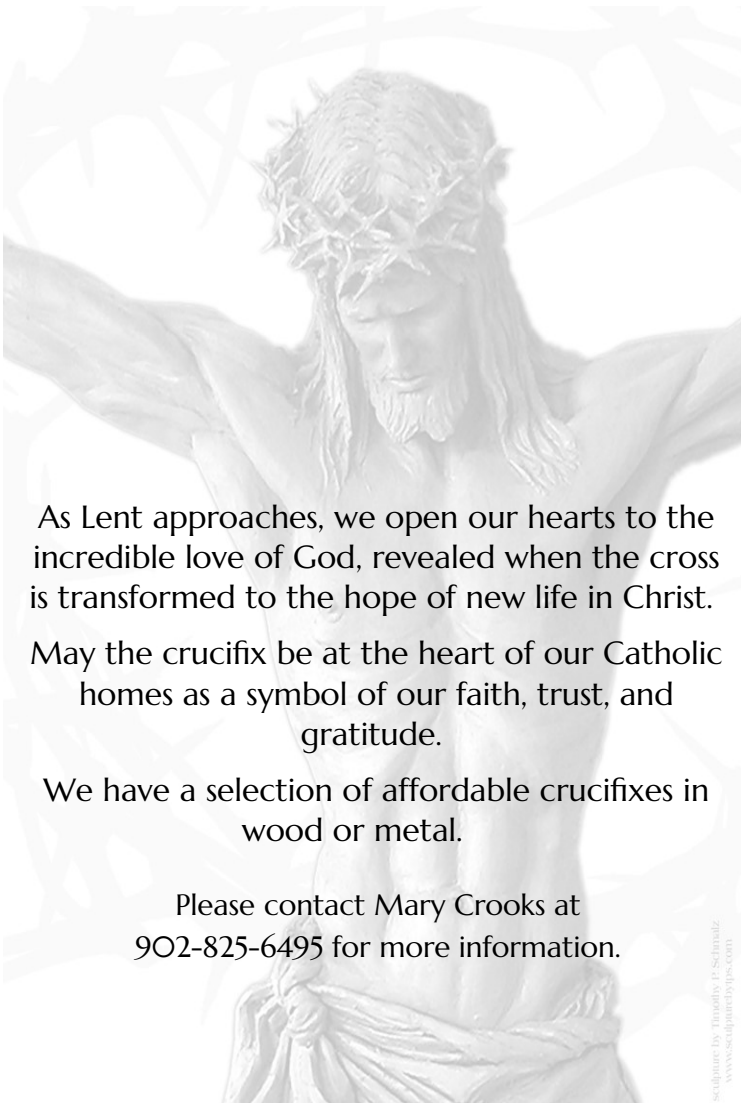

Fasting & Abstinence

When fasting is required, it applies to those aged 18 through 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller

meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Those age 14 and over are required to observe abstinence from meat when decreed.

SHROVE TUESDAY

Do you eat pancakes on Shrove Tuesday? Also known as Pancake Day, it is the day before Ash Wednesday.

Do you know that Shrove Tuesday was traditionally the day when people went to confession before the start of Lent and were "shriven" (absolved from their sins). A bell would be rung to call people to confession. This came to be called the "Pancake Bell" and is still rung today in some places.

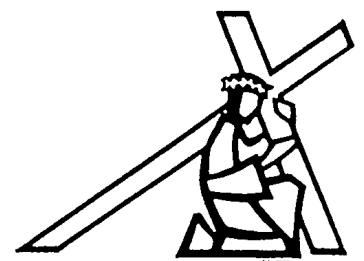

Synod News

Sometimes the word “synod” refers to an assembly of the **Synod of Bishops** – which happens once every three years. Recent synods have examined themes such as new evangelization, the family, young people and the Amazon. The next Synod of Bishops, in 2023, will focus on the topic of synodality itself.

In preparation for this 2023 Synod of Bishops, Pope Francis has asked all of the bishops to consult and pray with their own dioceses to help determine how synodality is being lived out in their midst and how we need to grow in our experience of journeying together.

The word “synod” also refers to “journeying together” – being a community that is united in purpose and mission, moving together in the same direction in this earthly pilgrimage.

Responses are coming in steadily for the Archdiocesan external consultation survey – thank you for helping promote this initiative! This is part of our synod outreach, and part of how we hope to better engage those outside our walls. Please continue to share this survey with people you know who may not currently participate in our Church. Personally inviting people you know is the best way to spread the word about this process while also starting a conversation with those around you.

Until the end of February, they want to hear from people who are not currently engaged in our Church, The [online survey](#) is for those who do not attend Mass or consider themselves involved with our Church.

The survey is short, open-ended, and anonymous. Please take some time to share this survey with people you know who are not part of our Church. They can be fallen away Catholics or people with no experience in the Catholic Church. A personal invitation from someone they know will be our best tool for this phase of the process.

Dear Fr. John & Parishoners,

Thank you for your very generous gift of \$6275 to the Emergency Shelters Project. While these shelters are not long-term solutions, they are a way to immediately provide support and dignity to some of our brothers and sisters who are without shelter.

Our Nova Scotia weather – from snowstorms to rainstorms to everything in between – demonstrates the need for a warm and safe place to call home, if even temporarily. I am tremendously grateful for and encouraged by the response to our fundraising request, with donations from other Christian churches and many generous individuals like you.

Thanks to your support, we have ordered a total of twenty emergency shelters for use in various regions of the diocese. These shelters will house twenty guests for the worst of the winter. The host parishes have teams in place that we hope will provide additional support and resources as they are able. While these are still not ideal living solutions, you have helped provide shelter to twenty individuals who may have gone without all winter.

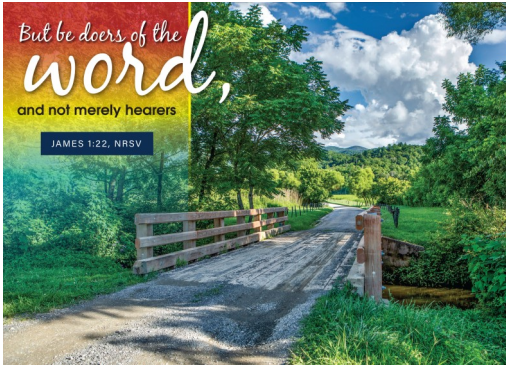
