Update on Plans for Pilgrimage Walk Through Corpus Christi Parish

Here are some of the tentative plans.

Dates: Tuesday, Oct 22, 2024 to Sunday, Oct 27, 2024 (First Half)

<u>Walk</u>: Starting at St John's Church in **Windsor**, we will begin walking on the rail bed in Grand Pre and finishing at St Alphonsus Church in **Bridgetown**. This will be the first half of the pilgrimage. The second part will take place in the Spring of 2025 and will begin at St Alphonsus Church in **Bridgetown** and end at St Joseph's Church in **Weymouth**. The average daily walk will be 20 km or less.

<u>Cost</u>: Participants doing the full walk will pay \$150 to cover the cost of food, transporting baggage and other miscellaneous expenses.
